Abstract:

As a Greek artist based in Athens in the heart of the economic crisis, I both witness and experience vulnerabilities exposed by structures of economic inequality, which has deeply affected my work as an artist. I see myself as a vulnerable agent. As an artist I am first a human activist and then a choreographer and performer. Durational vulnerability is a human condition. Throughout my work I question the boundaries of fragility, vulnerability and precarity in regards to the element of domination issue.
